

## **Double Glazing**

Poorly insulated window frames and single glazed windows account for up to 20 per cent of heat loss in the average home. Double glazing creates an insulating barrier by trapping air between two panes of glass. It can cut your heating bills by £60-£70 a year, as well as reducing noise and condensation.

If you can't afford to replace all your windows at once, start with the rooms that you heat the most. Alternatively, think about secondary glazing which costs less to install but could still save you money by cutting heat loss and draughts.
